

Airborne Edge-X Tundra Modification

AS YOU WILL KNOW FROM MY PREVIOUS ARTICLE MODIFYING YOUR MICROLIGHT, THE TUNDRA MODIFICATION IS A MAJOR MOD. AS SUCH, IT NOT ONLY REQUIRES AN ENTRY IN THE AIRCRAFT LOGBOOK, BUT ALSO APPROVAL FROM THE MANUFACTURER IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH CAO 95.32.

Currently, Airborne Australia are putting together an Approval package for this Mod. It consists of relevant drawings, installation instructions and an Approval certificate which details the conditions to be complied with in order to gain this approval.

By the time you read this article, anyone who has purchased a Tundra Modification Kit (Part No. 105204) should already have been contacted by Airborne Australia, and issued with an Approval. You should note that the Approval has certain criteria that must be met before the Approval comes into effect. If you



are currently an owner of an Edge-X trike which has the Tundra Kit already installed and have not been contacted by Airborne Australia regarding this Mod, then you should contact them and request approval, at your very earliest convenience.

Trike owners should remain aware that they are required by CAO 95.32 to obtain approval from the manufacturer prior to the installation of any Major Modification to their aircraft. Failure to do so renders the aircraft unserviceable and not fit to fly.
